
REPEATED COURSES POLICY**Excel Academy Policy for Repeating Courses**

Excel Academy Charter School and its programs emphasize student achievement and success. There are times when students do not earn the grade they expect, and they need or want to retake the course for a better grade. We allow students to repeat courses with certain provisions:

Students may repeat courses if they earned a grade of D or F. The previous lower grade and credits will be excluded from the grade point average (GPA) calculation. The higher of the two grades will be counted toward the cumulative GPA. There is no limit to the number of times a student may repeat the same course in which they earned a D or F. There is no limit to the number of courses students may repeat. Courses that have earned a grade of C or better cannot be repeated for higher GPA. Repeated courses will be indicated on the transcript /r/.

Students earning a D in any course who wish to improve their grade may repeat the course.

Students earning an F in a core course required for graduation must repeat the course.

Students earning an F in a non-core course required for graduation are not obligated to repeat the course as long as the minimum number of credits have been met for graduation.

Please refer to your four-year plan and speak with your School Counselor to confirm whether a course must be repeated in order to graduate.

Students interested in applying to a 4-year college should be aware that most four-year institutions only allow a course to be repeated one time for grade replacement. Please review the websites for any college and/or university of interest to verify the individual policy.
