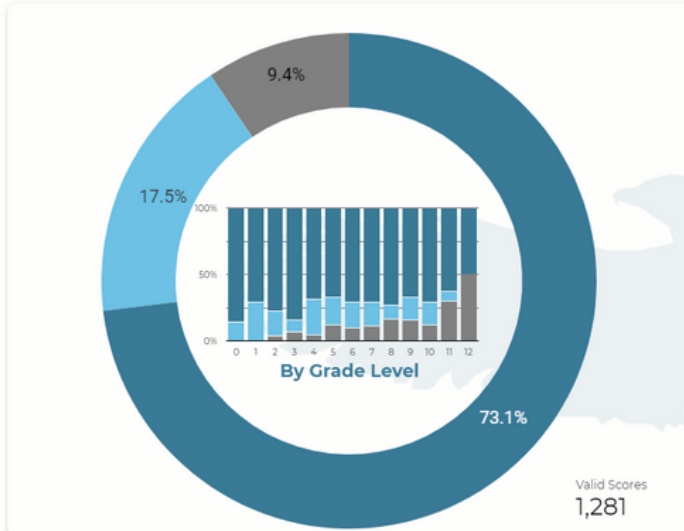


LOCAL TEST 2020-21 ELA Fall to Spring Matched-Student Analysis

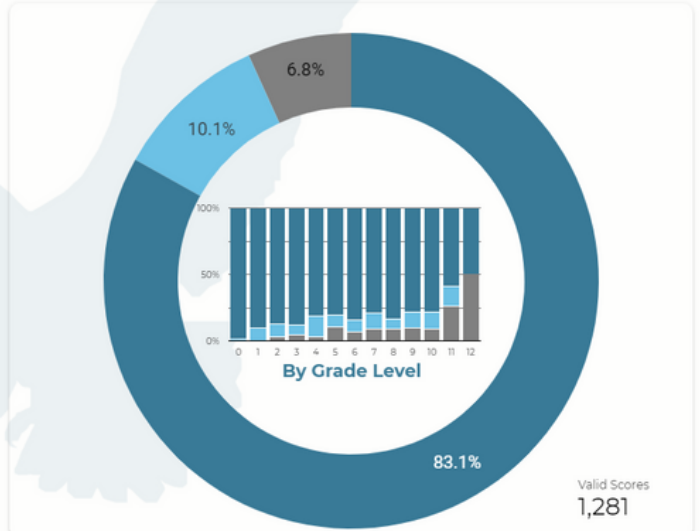
2020-21 Fall Test Results

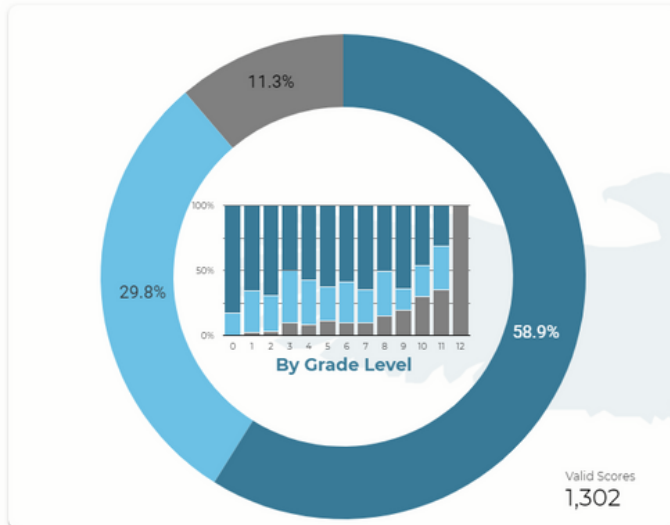

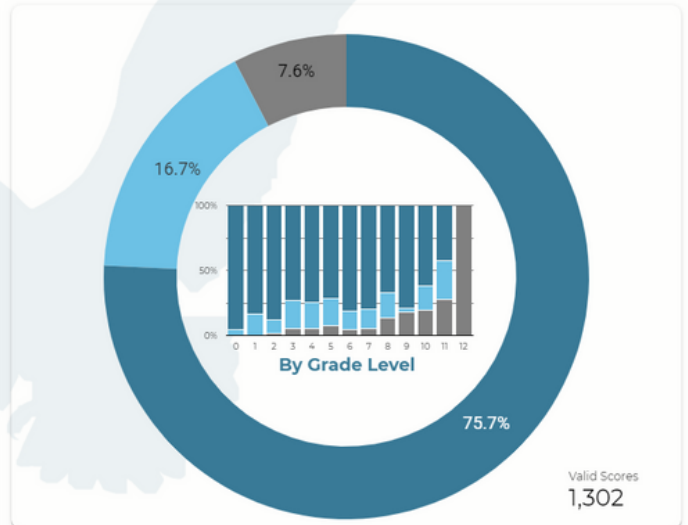
2020-21 Fall Test Results

When we compare the fall and spring score reports in math, we see that close to 76% of our students are working at or above grade level. This is a 16% increase in tier 1!
